INTERAGENCY INITIAL ATTACK COORDINATION 8135.1
(May 1995)

Unit ECC's and adjacent federal agency dispatch offices shall work directly with each other using their locally controlled resources to obtain maximum effectiveness.

Commitment of unit initial response (first alarm) resources to a federal incident shall be reported to the responsible Region CC by the unit ECC within 5 minutes of the commitment.

INTERAGENCY RESPONSE AUGMENTATION 8135.2
(No. 19 May 2002)

Requests for supplemental resources to CDF from a federal agency, or vice versa, must be placed with the respective GACC dispatch office or Region CC.

Requests for supplemental resources will follow the command channels depicted in [HB 8100 Exhibit - Command Channels for Resource Ordering](#). A region may request resources directly from the GACC in which the incident is located, and vice versa; however, the resources assigned by the filling region or GACC must be located within the administrative boundaries of the requesting region or GACC. Requests for supplemental resources outside the requesting region or GACC's administrative area will be made through normal channels.
