

MODULAR AIRBORNE FIRE FIGHTING SYSTEM (MAFFS) 8355

(Revised September 2001)

The MAFFS objective is to provide emergency backup to commercial airtankers, using C-130 Hercules aircraft capable of carrying 3,000 gallons of retardant. MAFFS are to be used as a reinforcement measure when suitable commercial airtankers are not readily available.

CDF may activate up to 2 MAFFS on a state activation, activation of any more than this requires a federal activation.
