

OUT-OF-STATE USE OF CDF PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT

Through the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement with the USDA Forest Service and the Bureau of Land Management, and the Interstate Compact, CDF may respond with resources to emergency incidents outside the State of California. Each fiscal year the department submits a request for blanket out-of-state travel authority to support these responses. Additionally, the following criteria must be met:

- The request must come from either the National Interagency Coordination Center (Boise) via Northern or Southern Geographical Area Command Centers or the headquarters of any state which is signatory to the Interstate Compact (Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Nevada and Utah).
- The request must have an appropriate order and request number.
- The response of personnel and/or equipment out of state must not compromise CDF's ability to perform its protection responsibilities within California.
