

## **FIRE PREVENTION ACTIVITIES BY AGENCIES**

Federal agencies and the CDF cooperate on fire prevention efforts. The following presents fire prevention roles by agency.

### **US Forest Service (USFS)**

- Enforce state forest and fire laws on SRA within USFS direct protection.
- Issue campfire and burning permits.
- Make fire prevention inspections.
- Request criminal prosecution for violators.
- CDF enforces laws on USFS land in CDF direct protection area.

### **Bureau of Land Management (BLM)**

- Provide primary fire prevention service and enforce state forest and fire laws on SRA and both agencies cooperate in all areas of mutual fire prevention interest.
- Issue campfire and burning permits.
- Make fire prevention inspections.

### **Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)**

- Both agencies cooperate in initiating programs to reduce fire hazards on, and promote fire prevention education concerning, Indian lands.
- Additionally, BIA funds a CDF fire captain for arson and fire hazard reduction and to promote fire prevention information and education on the Morongo Valley Indian Reservation.

### **National Park Service (NPS)**

- Enforce state forest and fire laws for SRA within park boundaries.
- Issue burning permits.
- Make fire prevention inspections.

- Request criminal prosecution.
- CDF enforces fire laws on park lands within CDF direct protection area.
- Both agencies cooperate in all areas of mutual fire prevention interest adjacent to SRA.

### **Corps of Engineers (COE)**

- CDF provides primary fire prevention to COE lands within CDF direct protection.
- Both agencies cooperate in all areas of mutual fire prevention interest.

### **Bureau of Reclamation (BOR)**

- CDF provides fire prevention services at the same level as other lands within CDF direct protection.
- BOR funds a fire captain to perform supplemental fire protection services consisting of additional fire prevention activities required by the increased risk resulting from construction activities associated with the proposed Auburn Dam construction project.

### **Fish and Wildlife Service (F & WS)**

- Both parties cooperate in initiating programs to reduce fire hazards and promote fire prevention on refuge lands.
