

CHAPTER 8660 - USING THE FIREFINDER AS A RANGEFINDER **(1987)**

The rear sight of most firefinders is designed to be used as a rangefinder to measure exact distances from the lookout to a smoke location when used in conjunction with topographic maps of the terrain around a lookout tower.
