Every Unit should solicit the support of local officials, citizens and advocacy groups to facilitate adoption of Fire Safe standards. Public education efforts should use existing and locally developed publications, news releases and interviews with the media, and presentations at club, group and public presentations. Each and every wildland resident and wildland user must understand the steps necessary to act in a fire safe manner. They must accept the responsibility of self-protection by implementing the requirements of law and appropriate Fire Safe recommendations. Public oriented activities shall be incorporated into the Unit Fire Prevention Plan.
