Special education students include those that require special assistance as well as gifted (exceptional) children. Other special circumstances include bilingual children, and children with psychological problems, specifically those who have had an experience with fire (fire children). You should treat fire children in the same manner as other equivalent age groups. Fire children have a unique problem and may require individual consideration. The key to successful contact with this group is a pre-program meeting with the teacher; his/her input will aid you in getting your message across.
