Lobby displays can be either the hardest or the easiest exhibiting challenge. Large-scale mockups, life-size reproductions, or actual items can depict most anything in our profession. These can include a cutaway of a centrifugal pump, a display of tools used in firefighting, panel picture stories of CDF's programs and responsibilities, or particular themes such as fire control or fire prevention emphasized with appropriate material. You can have a uniformed CDF employee in attendance at the display to answer questions and give out literature. A small table with appropriate literature and handout material should be provided when the display is not attended. Vandalism may be a problem, so precautions should be taken to safeguard the display by roping off the area, securing loose items, and having an inventory of all materials exhibited.
