

FIREWORKS AND EXPLOSIVE TRANSPORTATION

Hazardous Devices Technicians shall be permitted to keep a total of four pounds of high explosives in their vehicle. The high explosives shall be stored in a locking, heavy gauge metal container lined with wood.

Hazardous Devices Technicians shall be permitted to keep a total of ten non-electric blasting caps, six electric blasting caps and six-shock tube blasting caps in their vehicles. All of the blasting caps shall be stored in a locking, heavy gauge metal container lined with wood.

Transportation of fireworks or explosives shall be in compliance with Health and Safety Code Sections beginning with Sections 12000, 12500, and the California Vehicle Code. Exigent circumstances may preclude this requirement.

Exception: In a hazardous or unusual situation, the exceptions permitted under Sections 12005 of the Health and Safety Code, 12303 of the Penal Code, may be utilized at the discretion of the Hazardous Devices Technician in charge.
